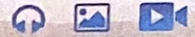

## Landforms

Landforms include plateaus, mountains, hills and plains. A plateau is an area of land that is raised up and flat on top, often near mountains. A mountain is an area of land that rises up very tall and very steep. Hills are areas of land that are not as tall or steep as mountains. Plains are lower, flatter areas of land.
